What to do if I am concerned?

Remember safeguarding is everyone's business!

A child tells me about abuse

(Disclosure)

Tell the child you **cannot keep** this a secret if you think the child is not safe.

LISTEN to the child. Be careful of body language.

Wherever possible, make notes of what the child says. Do not ask yes/ no questions.

Where possible write the concerns on a sheet/ log on safeguard.

As quickly as possible take your concern to the Designated safeguarding lead who is Mrs A Ratford.

If the Designated safeguarding lead is unavailable contact the Deputy designated safeguarding lead who is

If the deputy safeguarding lead is unavailable then report to part of the safeguarding team.

Mrs C James, Mrs N McNichol or Mrs J Osborne.
