School Uniform

Recently we have noticed that several children are coming to school in clothes that are not a part of our school uniform.

All pupils, including nursery, should be wearing uniform every day. This should consist of:

- Black trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Tartan skirt or dress
- White polo shirt
- Royal blue jumper or cardigan
- Black shoes or trainers

Hair accessories should be small and blue or white ONLY

If your child is still bring a large, rucksack style bag to school this needs to be replaced with a smaller bookbag style bag.

Please ensure that you write your child's name in ALL of their uniform.
