



Literacy - Squabble, row, spot, munch, tip

This half term we will be learning the story of Mr Gumpy's Outing by John Burningham

**<u>Key questions</u>**: How can we change the story? How can we act out the story for an audience.

**<u>Activity:</u>** We will be creating a story map and learning how we can change the characters of the story.

### **Understanding the World**

Past, present, change, recent, memory This half term we will be learning about how transport was different in the past.

<u>Key questions:</u> How was transport different in the past?

**<u>Activity:</u>** We will be looking at vehicles and transport past and present.

# Understanding the

**World** – Country, same, different, ocean This half term we will be looking at world maps and talking about different countries.

<u>Key questions:</u> What countries are in the world?

<u>Activity:</u> We will be inviting parents to come in and talk about what it was like growing up in the country they are from.

#### Understanding the World – Islam, Muslim, Muhammad, mosque

This half term we will be will be learning about why Muhammed is important to Muslim people.

Key questions: Who was Muhammad?

**<u>Activity</u>**: We will be looking at non-fiction books and inviting Muslim friends to talk to the children about Islam.

'Ready, Steady, Go' Reception – Spring Term 1

Maths – zero, part, whole, more, less, before, after, subitise

This half term we will be will be learning about the value of zero and making one more and one less.

**Key questions:** What two parts make a whole? How many altogether? What is one more? What is one less?

**Activity:** We will be using objects to create sets and totals, and counting one more and one less.

<u>Computing</u> – Sequence, order, first, next, then

This half term we will be looking at programmable toys

Key questions: Can we sequence the events of Mr Gumpy's journey?

**<u>Activity:</u>** We will be using Beebots to programme directions and make journeys.

Understanding the World – Sound, loud, quiet, vibration

This half term we will be learning to hear and identifying different sounds

Key questions: What sounds can we hear?

**<u>Activity:</u>** We will be exploring musical instruments, vibrations caused by sounds, and sounds made by vehicles.
