NURSERY	<ul> <li>Know that different musical instruments make different sounds and to differentiate between the sounds, sharing thoughts and feelings about what they have heard</li> <li>Listen to and join in with Nursery rhymes and use musical instruments to tap out a rhythm</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use their imagination to create different works of art</li> <li>Play instruments to express feelings and ideas</li> <li>Play instruments with increasing control</li> <li>Use their knowledge of stories in acting them out with friends</li> <li>Sing songs clearly using correct words that have been learned</li> <li>Know how to create recognisable representations of objects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Know how to use props appropriately for particular stories</li> <li>Know they can change their voices while singing or acting out stories to create a dramatic effect</li> <li>Know how to use available props to develop stories and make imaginative play more purposeful</li> <li>Know that body movements can be changed depending on the rhythm to achieve a desired effect</li> <li>Know that different construction toys can be used to make new things that can be used in pretend play</li> <li>Begin to develop complex stories using small world equipment like animal sets, dolls and dolls houses, etc.</li> </ul>
RECEPTION	<ul> <li>Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses</li> <li>Watch and talk about dance and performance art, expressing their feelings and responses</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody</li> <li>Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups</li> <li>Develop storylines in their pretend play</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Invent, adapt and recount narratives and stories with peers and their teacher</li> <li>Sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and songs</li> <li>Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and – when appropriate – try to move in time with music</li> <li>Make use of props and materials when role playing characters in narratives and stories</li> </ul>
