Entry Point – To create a class display of rainbows.

Expressive Arts and Design – *music, song, voice, high, low*

This half term we will be learning and remembering how to sing new songs.

Key questions: How can I sing to an audience?

Activity:

We will be performing songs to our friends. We will practise singing in a clear, loud voice and to look at our audience confidently.

Understanding the World – *animal, legs, tail, beak, wings*

This half term we will be learning about animals and using vocabulary to describe them.

Key questions: Can we name and describe different animals?

Activity:

We will be categorising farm animals, wild animals, woodland animals and sea creatures. We will then think of the words we could use to describe them.

Computing – *order, first, next, then*

This half term we will be learning how to sequence.

Key questions: Can we sequence events in a story?

Activity:

We will be sequencing the events in our story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do you see?'

Expressive Arts & Design – *paint, colour, mix* This half term we will be learning about colours and what happens when we mix them together.

Key questions: What colours can we make?

Activity:

Children will be learning how to mix colours using powder paint. We will paint rainbows, mixing our own colours.

Nursery – Autumn Term

Personal, Social and Emotional Development – *home, friend, family, kind*

This half term we will be learning how to take care of our friends and start to solve conflicts.

Key questions: How can I help others?

Activity:

We will engage in circle time activities discussing how we can help our friends in nursery and what to do if we have a disagreement. We will also be reading 'Little Robin Red Vest' and thinking about how kind the little robin was to his friends.

Understand the World – *Christmas, Jesus,*

This half term we will be sharing our experiences of Christmas and other special celebrations.

Key questions: Why is Christmas special?

Activity:

We will be reading the Nativity Story and discussing our experiences of Christmas.

Maths – *shape, curved, side, corners.*

This half term we will be learning about different shapes and their properties

Key questions: What makes a triangle a triangle? What makes a square a square? What makes a circle a circle? What makes a rectangle a rectangle?

Activity:

Children will be identifying different shapes and discussing their properties. Children will create their own shape pictures and will talk about the shapes they have used and why.
