**Entry Point** – To join different materials together.

**Expressive Arts and Design** – *fabric, glue, tape, join*

This half term we will be learning about different materials and ways of joining them together.

**Key questions:** How can we create a character? What materials will I use? How will I join them together?

**Activity:** We will be exploring different materials and adhesives such as glue and tape. We will be planning how to make a stick puppet character.

**Understanding the World** – *animal, fish, skin, fur, feathers, scales*

This half term we will be learning about animals and their different features and where they live.

**Key questions:** How are animals different from each other? What animals live on the land? What animals can fly?

**Activity:** We will be using our vocabulary to animals by where they live and their features.

**Computing** – *computer, screen, mouse, keyboard*

This half term we will be learning about the different parts of a computer.

**Key questions:** What are the different parts of a computer?

**Activity:** When we use the computer and interactive whiteboard we will use our vocabulary to talk about them.

**Expressive Arts and Design** – *collage, glue, tape*

This half term we will be learning about fitting shapes together using glue and tape.

**Key questions:** How can we collage with different materials.

**Activity:** We will be using scissors to cut shapes and join them together.

**Understanding the World** – *school, Dagenham, London, shop, park, roads, buildings*

This half term we will be learning about where we live.

**Key questions:** What is in my local area?

**Activity:** We will be, going on a local walk and talking about the features of our community.

**Understanding the World** – *Christmas, Jesus, Christians, angel, gifts*

This half term we will be learning about different beliefs and different ways of celebrating special times.

**Key questions:** What happen during the first Christmas?

**Activity:** We will be reading different versions of the Christmas Story. We will talk about the ways Christians celebrate Christmas.

**Physical Development** – *movement, travel, stop, directions*

This half term we will be learning how to move our bodies safely and in different ways. We are also learning how to dress and undress by ourselves.

**Key questions:** How can I move safely in different ways?

**Activity:** We will be exploring how to travel and move in different directions.

**Exit Point** – To make a stick puppet as one of our story characters.
