
































Entry Point – ZooLab 'Wriggle and Crawl Roadshow

Subject - Understanding of the World - Science

Vocab: Grow, change, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly

This half term we will be learning about the life cycle of a caterpillar.

Key question: How do animals grow and change?

Activity: We will have caterpillars in class and observe them turn into butterflies. Children will have the opportunity to care for them, observe them closely and then release them.

Subject: Understanding of the World – Geography

Vocab: House, flat, town, Dagenham

This half term we will be learning about where we live.

Key question: Where do we live?

Activity: Children will be looking at maps of our local area. Children will share information about where they live and who lives there with them.

Subject: Expressive Arts and

Design – Art

Vocab: Draw, line, circle, shape

This half term we will be learning how do draw farm animals

Key question: How can we draw an animal?

<u>Activity:</u> We will be drawing a range if farmyard animals using simple lines and shapes.

<u>Subject:</u> Understanding of the World - RE

Vocab: Easter, Jesus, Christian

This half term we will be learning about Faster

<u>Key question:</u> Why is Easter Special?

Activity: We will be learning why we celebrate Easter and making Easter cards for our family.

Nursery – Spring Term 2

<u>Subject</u>: Personal, Social and emotional Development

Vocab: Belong, school, friends, family

This half term we will be thinking about how it feels to belong to our family and our school.

<u>Key question:</u> Where do I belong?

Activity: We will discuss belonging to our family and school. We will draw a picture of our family.

Subject: Maths

Vocab: Pattern, repeat

This half term we will be exploring different patterns and learning that patterns can be both visual and auditory.

Key question: How can we make a pattern?

Activity: We will be exploring different patterns and then we will create our own.

Subject: Computing - programming

Vocab: order, first, next, then

This half term we will be learning the sequence of the life cycle of a caterpillar.

Key question: Can we sequence the life cycle of a caterpillar?

Activity: We will be working together to put the images of an egg, caterpillar chrysalis, and butterfly in the correct sequence.
