



















Entry Point - Local Walk

Literacy – lonely, coiled, dangling, shrieking, perched

This half term we will be reading Monkey Puzzle by Julia Donaldson.

<u>Key questions:</u> How can we change the story? How can use nonfiction books to learn about new animals?

Computing -

<u>Activity:</u> We will be making story maps and sequencing the story.

Art – Paint, mix, dark, light, bright This half term we will be learning to mix colours to make new colours and different shades

Key questions: How can we paint a jungle?

<u>Activity:</u> Looking at jungle scenes from India and creating our own.

Direct, forward, backwards, left, righ turn This half term we will be learning to sequence a journey.

<u>Key questions:</u> Can we direct the baby monkey to his Mum?

<u>Activity:</u> Using a large map help direct Monkey to his mother.

Religious Education – Hindu, gods, goddesses, Mandir, worship

This half term we will be learning about Hinduism.

Key questions: What do Hindus believe?

<u>Activity</u>: We will be taking a virtual tour of a mandir and learn how Hindus worship.

Maths - doubling, combining, length, height

This half term we will be learning how to double numbers, combine groups to make a whole number, and measure length, height, and time.

<u>Key questions:</u> What does double mean? How many in each group? How many altogether? Which is longer, shorter, taller, shorter?

Activity: We will be using different resources to find out how many altogether. We will be measuring using non-standard measurements.

Reception — Sprina Term 2 <u>Geography</u>-

India, jungle, mountain, river

This half term we will be learning about India.

Key questions: What is it like in India?

<u>Activity</u>: Looking at and talking about images and non-fiction books about India.

<u>Science</u> – Plant, leaf, stem, flower, petal, fruit, tree, bush

This half term we will be learning about plants.

Key questions: What do we notice about different plants?

<u>Activity</u>: Exploring different plants and planting seeds to observe how they grow.
