Entry Point – Treasure hunt / map around the school to find Jack's magic beans

Subject – Science

Vocabulary: evergreen, deciduous, root, stem, blossom, petals, fruit, seed, bulb, trunk, branch

This half term we will be learning how to identify garden and wild plants.

Key questions: How can we identify different plants?

Activity: find a book or website about tree and flower identification. Take a walk and see how many plants you can identify.

Subject – Geography

Vocabulary: North, East, South, West, compass, direction, map, route

This half term we will be finding out about maps and how a compass can help us to find our way

Key questions: How do we read a map?

Activity: Look at a map of the local area. See what landmarks you can identify. See if you can find your home on the map. How does this compare to the 'street view' and a 'bird's eye view'?

Subject – RE

Vocab: Islam, Muslim, community, Muhammed, Qur'an, prayer mat, Ramadan, Hajj

This half term we will be learning what Muslims do and believe.

Key questions: What does it mean to be a Muslim?

Activity: Think about the similarities between what Muslims believe and do and what you believe and do.

Subject – Art

Vocab: colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space

This half term we will create collages using natural materials.

Key questions: How can we create a collage using natural materials?

Activity: create a garden or park collage using only natural materials you found in the park or garden.

Year 1 – Summer Term 1

Subject – DT

Vocab: Diet, carbohydrate, dairy, oils, sugar, protein, fats, balanced diet, fruit, vegetable

This half term we will be learning where food comes from and what to eat to keep us healthy

Key question: Where does our food come from?

Activity: where does the food you are eating come from? See if you can find the county on a map. Decide which food group it belongs to and why it helps us stay healthy (or not!)

Subject – Computing

Vocab: Label, match, group, property

This half term we will organise, count and group data

Key questions: What can we use to group and sort information?

Activity: Group, count, and label your toys at home. Does this help you to tidy quickly and find what you need?

Subject – PHSE

Vocab: Family Belong Different Same Friends Friendship Qualities Caring Sharing Kind

This half term we will be finding out about how things might change for us as we grow.

Key questions: How have I changed since I was a baby?

Activity: Look at photos of you as you have grown. Think about how you have changed. Ask family members if there are any lovely memories they have of you.
