Entry Point – Seaside role play

Subject – History

Vocabulary: Holiday, journey, past, present

This half term we will be discovering what holidays were like in the past.

Key questions: How have holidays changed over time?

Activity: Look back at photos from holidays and days out. Discuss and remember the fun times together.

Subject – DT

Vocabulary: Join, finish, sew, staple, needle, thread, template

This half term we will be making a puppet using fabric and learning different techniques to join materials together.

Key questions: How do we make a puppet from fabric?

Activity: Look at different fabrics around the home. See if there is a label saying the name of the fabric. How do different fabrics feel and differ?

Subject – RE

Vocab: Sikhism, Guru Nanak, symbol, belonging, Amrit

This half term we will be learning what Sikhs do and believe.

Key questions: What does it mean to be a Sikh?

Activity: Think about the similarities between what Sikhs believe and do and what you believe and do.

Subject – Art

Vocab: pattern, texture, line, shape, form.

This half term we will create line drawings

Key questions: How can we use lines and shapes to draw a sea creature?

Activity: Create line drawings of animals and objects you can find at home.



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Year 1 –Summer Term 2

Subject – PE

Vocab: throw, distance, target, control

This half term we will be learning tennis and athletic skills

Key question: How can I throw accurately to hit a target?

Activity: Practise throwing and catching. Place an object on the ground and see if you can throw a ball to this 'target'

Subject – Computing

Vocab: Sprite, design, programming blocks, algorithm, programs

This half term we will program a moving character.

Key questions: How can we move a character?

Activity: Practise giving instructions to a friend or family member so they can follow a route.

Subject – PHSE

Vocab: change, grow, excited, worried

This half term we will be finding out about how things might change for us as we grow.

Key questions: How have I changed since I was a baby?

Activity: Look at photos of you as you have grown. Think about how you have changed. Ask family members if there are any lovely memories they have of you.
